

- Man and Mountains an exhibit on the history of settlement in the Krkonoše Mts. from the gradual arrival of man in search of the bounties of the mountains, to the development of metallurgy, glass-making, lodge and forestry management, to scientific understanding and the commencement of tourism.

- A historical-ethnographic exhibit of the western Krkonoše Mts. from the 13th century to the present day, with an emphasis on the Harrach noble family, especially Jan Nepomuk Harrach (1828-1909)
- A rich collection of rustic furniture and Krkonoše nativity scenes, including the nativity scene by Jáchym Metelka from 1883-1903 with mechanically produced sound.
- A gallery with works by the prominent Czech landscape painter František Kaván (1866-1941).




The Krkonoše National Park Information Centres offer visitors to the Krkonoše Mts. comprehensive information regarding the national park, including trips to points of interest, scenic areas and tourism sights in the country's highest mountain range. Each information centre features a small exhibition highlighting interesting facts about the nature and history of the Krkonoše Mts., including a number of games for children. We also offer opportunities to screen films with an ecological theme and to host lectures. School groups can arrange to be accompanied by a Krkonoše National Park ranger, who will provide information on the relevant location directly in the field.


Krkonoše Environmental Education Centre - Krtek

The Krkonoše Environmental Education Centre - KRTEK is expanding its offer of educational activities for the general public. This is the place to hold public lectures and conferences. The centre contains a lecture theatre with a capacity of 76 places + 2 wheelchair accessible places for disabled visitors. Thanks to the use of a wide screen and surround sound it has the parameters of a small cinema. A laboratory and a classroom may also be used for lessons. The direct contact between the theoretical and practical teaching plays an important role in the education. Therefore the laboratory is an integral part of the centre. The laboratory has a capacity of 16 students and the classroom accommodates 30 students. The building also contains an exhibition space, library, ecological advice centre and parking spaces for clients.

Free tours are available every Tuesday from 3 PM to 5 PM, and at other times other times by appointment.
